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ENERGIZER AND CALIFORNIA PROP 65

California Proposition 65 (Prop 65), established initially as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, requires the state of California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. Prop 65 also prohibits businesses from exposing product users to substances on the published list without providing clear warning in the form of labels or other communications.

All Energizer products sold into the state of California meets the requirements of Proposition 65 as of the listed date May 15, 2018. If required, products contain the appropriate warnings as defined in Federal, State and California regulations. As the Prop 65 list changes, Energizer continually monitors these changes to assess how these changes may affect Energizer products. If necessary, product or labeling modifications are made.
